The CSAH 2 Reconstruction Project will include the reconstruction of sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewer, services, street lighting, and landscape architecture. This project is a combined effort with Stearns County. This project is estimated to start May 18, 2016 and will extend into fall of this year.

The Prime Contractor is Knife River Corporation. The City appreciates your cooperation and patience during this important project. Please remember to drive safely in and around this project site.

Right-of-Way

Now is the time to start removing items such as electric dog fences, sprinkler systems and other landscaping items from the right-of-way, at the front of your property. Contact Dan if you would like us to review it with you.

The contractor will make every effort to provide access to driveways at the end of the day. During working hours, driveway access may not be available.

No street parking will be allowed on CSAH 2 during the project. Please don't park on the street unless directed to do so by construction personnel.

PROTECTING YOUR VALUABLES

During the project, the Contractor will need to use certain equipment that may cause vibrations in the adjacent properties. We recommend that any valuables you have in your home or business be taken off of the walls and/or shelves and properly secured to reduce the potential risk of damage to those items.

MAIL & REFUSE SERVICES

We are in contact with the Post Office and the refuse haulers to coordinate service during the project. For your refuse pick-up, you should plan to place your containers at the end of your driveway according to your current schedule.

CONSTRUCTION STAKES

Please assist us, by preserving any survey stakes or utility flags placed on your property during construction. These stakes need to be placed far enough from the construction so they are not destroyed by the excavation. Missing and destroyed stakes result in additional re-staking costs and can delay the project. Since we understand that stakes can be mis-used for toys, please talk to your children about the importance of leaving them in place.

PRIVATE SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT

Residents should be starting to think about whether or not to replace your existing water and sewer service lines from the property line to your home. If you would like to use this opportunity to upgrade your private lines, please contact your private excavating company or the City for a list of local contractors. This work is outside of the City project and would be at the property owner's expense.
