**Safety-** Thank you for your assistance in helping us maintain a safe project site so far this summer. With fall approaching, the project will be wrapping up. Let's not forget about safety in and around the project site. Be aware of large trucks hauling materials and the Contractor's equipment moving up and down the roadway.

## Project Update

The underground utility installation is complete. The contractor is finishing up the roundabout area. Residents and businesses are advised that there will be a change in the local traffic detour beginning Wednesday, August 31, 2016. Traffic on CSAH 2 and CSAH 50 will be directed to use the new roundabout. CSAH 2 south of the roundabout will remain closed. The detour behind the brewery will remain in effect. The detour through the ROCORI parking lot will be closed. Motorists are urged to use caution when traveling through the roundabout. Detour signs will be posted.

Over the next several weeks, the remainder of the road will be constructed, including curb and gutter and pavement. Work on the sidewalks and streetscape will continue as well. Construction personnel will continue to utilize the roadway for work access, even in the areas that are already paved. The safety of the construction workers is the number one priority on the project.

## Driveway Access

The contractor will make every effort to provide access to driveways at the end of each day; however upcoming concrete work will restrict some access to driveways. Construction personnel will be in contact with you regarding your driveway access. No street parking will be allowed on CSAH 2 during the project. Please don't park on the street unless directed to do so by construction personnel.

It can be a difficult process navigating through construction equipment, traveling over the bumpy roads, and dealing with the mud and dust. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.
